We hope you will share in our vision and join us in supporting this event in 2010 and in years to come.

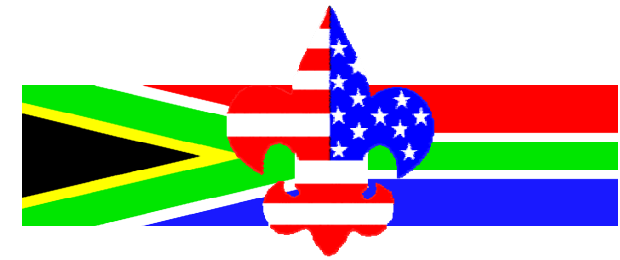
